Equipment List

- We will provide a comprehensive list of equipment to bring nearer the time but this is an idea of what we would advise the children to bring with them:
- A wheeled suitcase is most desirable as students are dropped off at the gate
- Waterproof coat
- Warm jumpers/hats/gloves
- Changes of clothing
- Small rucksack
- Torch
- Comfortable clothing
- Plastic water bottle (refillable)
- Lunch (for Day 1)
- Cash for the Braeside Gift Shop (optional)
- Comfortable walking shoes/wellies
- Slippers/trainers for indoors
- Pyjamas
- Towels, soap, toothbrush, toothpaste
- Large plastic bag to take home damp/dirty clothes
- Sun hat/sun cream (if hot)
- Personal medication (if required)

Cost

- The price of the residential for the full four days will be advised at the meeting on Wednesday 11th February
(this is based on 55 children attending. This price may change depending on final numbers).
- We are requesting that the deposit of £75 is paid by the end of February. This will be open to start paying tomorrow – Wednesday 4th February
- Further installments can then be paid. There will be 5 further payments to be paid between April and August. If you would prefer to pay in full, this will also be an option. You must ensure that the instalment plan is followed and paid on time please.
